They are as follows: firstly, the fate of all tasks carried out in society is connected with the level of development of the thinking and consciousness of the people living in it. The intended goal cannot be achieved without changing their consciousness and thinking based on the essence and interest of the tasks they are trying to implement. In this sense, spirituality is an important mechanism for changing the life of society, and any state, based on its goals and interests, prioritizes its development. secondly, in the early years of independence, a struggle against any ideology in general began under the banner of abandoning the former Soviet ideology. This, in turn, began to have a negative impact on people's spirituality and formed values. In particular, some scientists in the press began to put forward the idea that, first of all, it is necessary to form an economic mindset, and spirituality arises on the basis of this economic mindset. As a result, a one-sided approach to life began to take a leading place in the psyche of people. Fourthly, another reason for the primacy of spirituality in state policy is that, regardless of whether the nation is large or small in terms of numbers, it has become a vital necessity to restore its status as a real subject, a creator and consumer of certain material and spiritual wealth, the presence of its own characteristics that are not found in others, and its own independent place, that is, as a true nation. Solving it is of practical importance for the future of the nation and the state. Fifthly, the Uzbeks are a people who

have made a huge contribution to world civilization. Their achievements in the field of spirituality, science, and culture have been serving the peoples of the world for centuries. However, during the Soviet regime, great work was also done to "remove" these achievements created by their ancestors from the minds and hearts of the Uzbek people. In the conditions of independence, it was necessary to restore it, to restore its worthy and just place in world civilization. And this can be achieved only through the development of spirituality.
