He was far from the limitations and fanaticism of sectarianism... Babur loved art and especially literature" [2.69 p.]. In fact, Babur was not only a king, a poet, but also a military strategist. In particular, if we recall the battle of Panipat on April 21, 1526, between the 12,000-strong army of the 43-year-old Babur and the 100,000-strong army of the Delhi Sultan Ibrahim Lodi, in which he threw 700 carts tightly tied together with ropes made of rawhide of oxen into battle. These carts knocked down the elephants and confused the enemy. The artillery cannons made by his master Aliquli dealt a crushing blow to the enemy [3. 18b]. This battle became a unique basis for today's defense and attack tactics, that is, it is equivalent to the use of anti-tank artillery.



These thoughts given in the "Baburnama" explain that by studying his life and creative work, we can develop new discoveries and ideas today.

Now our Armed Forces have improved significantly in organizational and structural terms. The mobility of structures, combat capability, and physical and moral training of servicemen have increased.
